

The standard polling feature for meetings allows you to create single choice or multiple choice polling questions, while advanced polling adds matching, ranked choice, short answer, and long answer options. You can also set correct answers to have the poll function as a quiz.

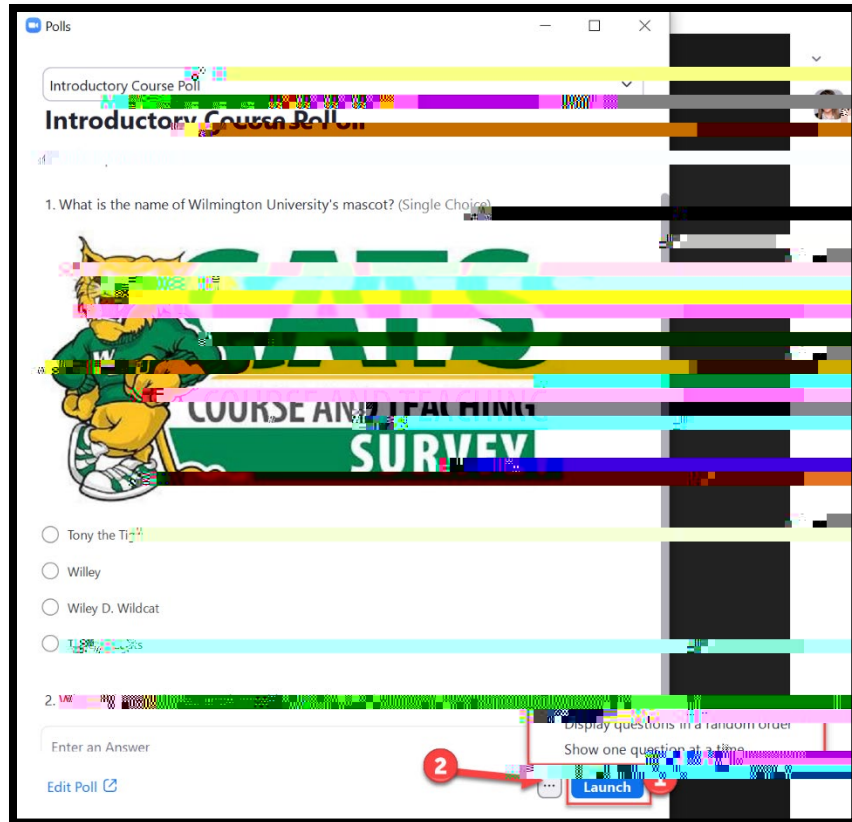
Note: To use Advanced Polling and Quiz features, the host user must be on a licensed Zoom account and both the host and participants must be on Zoom version 5.8.3 or higher. The host user must create the polls via a scheduled meeting or their Personal Meeting ID (PMI).

1. Begin by logging into your Zoom account at wilmu.zoom.us using your Wilmington University credentials.
2. Select "Meetings" and select your upcoming meeting to add a poll. If your meeting has not been created yet click "Schedule a New Meeting" and follow through the steps to create a new meeting.

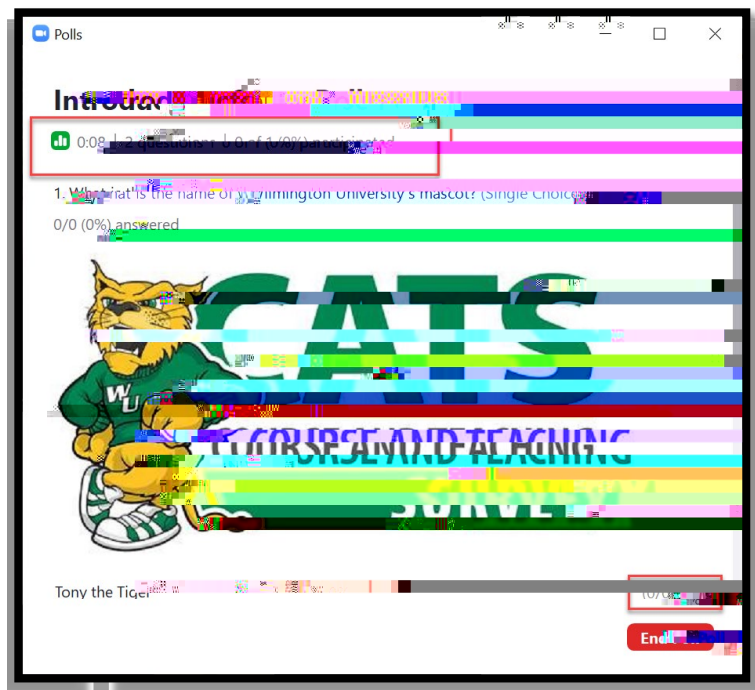
3. After selecting your scheduled meeting, scroll down to the bottom and select "Polls/Quizzes" to create a poll for this session. From the polling screen, click "Create+" to create a new poll. Select "Poll" or "Advanced Polls and Quizzing" depending on the type of poll you would like to create. Remember, to use Adva

7. After saving the poll, return to the polling menu where you can select "+Create" to create



- After launching the poll in the meeting, the progress bar will show how long the poll has been active and the percentage of participants (total as well as each question). It will also show live results as participants are voting. Select "End Poll" to end the polls and view the results.



- From the poll results, you can “Share Results” with participants. Selecting the “ellipses” provides options to relaunch the poll (removing current responses), download the results, or view the results in a web browser. Poll results can also be retrieved as a .CSV file from your Wilmington University Zoom account at wilmu.zoom.us after the Zoom meeting. After viewing and sharing the poll results, the host can select to launch an alternate poll by selecting the arrow in the top right corner.
